✓ In process: Ossabaw & Navassa (done by Aug 23).

✓ Next: Martinique, Kingston, Lasqueti, Maupiti, Jarvis, Inagua (finish mid-Sept).

Resident Reminders:

- No garbage pickup on your street during road workdays (Wed & Sat).
- Avoid driving on **fresh asphalt for 24 hours**.
- Do not move barricades/signs.
- Stay clear of trucks/equipment.
- Island Walk Circle (West/North) is very congested—avoid if possible.
- Guadeloupe will be closed during paving/removal dates (detours posted).
- Back Exit Gate remains closed.

08/12/2025 V3.0

DRIVING ON FRESH ASPHALT: IS PROHIBITED. WAIT AT LEAST 24 HOURS

Fresh asphalt:

- Driving on fresh asphalt **IS PROHIBITED**. WAIT AT LEAST 24 HOURS.
- Is soft and susceptible to damage from vehicles
- Needs time to cool before it is opened to traffic
- **Do not park vehicles** on your street on Fresh Asphalt.

How to Drive on Fresh Asphalt:

- **Do not turn your wheels** while your vehicle is stopped on Fresh Asphalt.
 - This will result in tearing of the asphalt surface.
- **Do ensure your vehicles are moving** (either frontwards or backwards) before turning your wheels

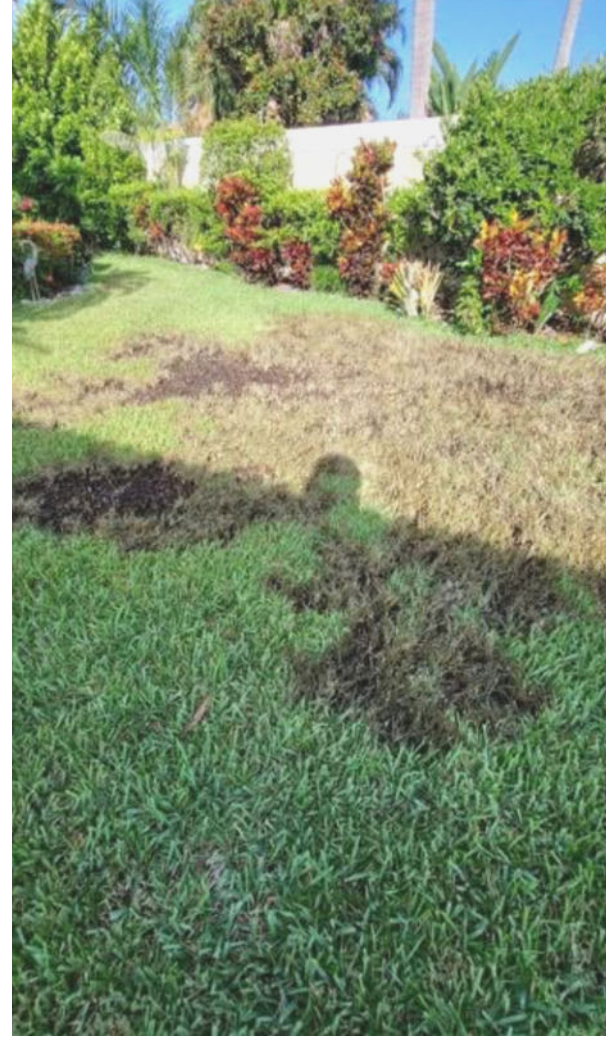



USE OF THE PUTTING GREEN

The Island Walk Putting Green is open to use by all Residents with privileges to use amenities and their Guests, subject to the following:

1. This new putting green is comprised of a special synthetic turf, and may be used for putting and chipping activities only. All chipping activity must take place from the chipping pads. All non golf-related activities are prohibited.
2. The putting green is open for use between the hours of sunrise and sunset.
3. Residents are responsible for any damage caused by them, their children, any of their Guests, and any child using the putting green under their supervision.
4. Children aged 10 and younger must be accompanied by an adult who shall be responsible for their actions.
5. A Guest must be accompanied by an adult Resident or have a Guest Pass.
6. Walkers, bicycles and other wheeled-devices are not allowed on the putting green.
7. Events organized by the Putting Green Committee or sponsored by the Association shall take precedence over other uses of the putting green.
8. Food, drink and glassware may not be used on the putting green.
9. No littering – Any person using the putting green and surrounding area is responsible for removing all trash and other debris generated by that person.
10. No pets are allowed on the putting green.
11. The putting green area is under video surveillance. Use of the putting green constitutes consent to such video surveillance and to the use by the Association of any images captured on such video surveillance.
12. **REMINDER:** The putting green is located within the Town Center campus, which is a designated **NO SMOKING AREA**.
13. **CAUTION:** By design, the putting green contains numerous elevation changes and uneven surfaces. **Use of the putting green constitutes assumption of all risks inherent in such elevation changes and uneven surfaces.**

House Numbers – Visibility Matters for Your Safety




House Numbers Matter!

Make sure your house number is easy to see—emergency responders depend on it.

House-Mounted Numbers

- Clearly visible at all times
- Black block-style Arabic numerals
- 4"-5" tall, 3"-4" wide, max 1" deep
- Mounted horizontally in the original or garage-adjacent location
- ACC approval required for all new or replacement numbers

 **Optional Ground Signs:** Allowed in planting beds (not grass), May be on a decorative rock or stake, **ACC approval required**

Wheeled Items – Where NOT to Ride

To keep our community safe, please don't ride bikes, scooters, golf carts, skateboards, or skates in these areas:

- Inside the Town Center, Fenced pool areas, Paver sidewalks (except lakeside path), Grass/turf in Town Center, Tennis courts, pavilion, lakeside gazebo, Gas station & nearby commercial lots

Parking Rules

- No parking bikes/scooters in pool areas or on sidewalks
- Use bike racks only

Golf Cart Guidelines

- Must be registered
- Allowed on streets & wide lakeside paths
- Not allowed on narrow residential sidewalks

FROM THE ACC: House Painting Anyone?

If you are planning to paint your home –

1. Obtain and read the ACC Requirements & Procedures, dated 04.09.2025. See Painting section.
2. Obtain the Intent to Paint form, dated 2.14.2024

This will save you time. If you have old forms, your application may not be correct and will be held or rejected until it is correct. Forms are available at the Town Center and on the Island Walk website IslandWalk-hoa.com under FORMS and ACC. Instructions are included on the form.

Planning to paint your house, trim, shutters, privacy wall? Here's how to make sure the color you request is correct. All Island Walk colors are based on PPG color codes. You or your contractor need to confirm that the paint brand you use is an EXACT MATCH with the PPG codes so the colors throughout Island Walk will be correct and uniform.

If you choose the Town Center color scheme, you will need to follow additional special instructions and sign a form saying that you will follow them. Paraffin body color requires using only Desert Dune trim, and these colors cannot be used with any other paint combinations. Accent colors are for doors and shutters only. You must give these instructions to your painter, and make sure they are followed. You will be responsible for any deviations from the rules. You'll see on the form that all paint colors and trim colors are required to be satin finish. Paint with a sheen or shine is not approved. If you have questions, please ask in the office 239-513-0045.

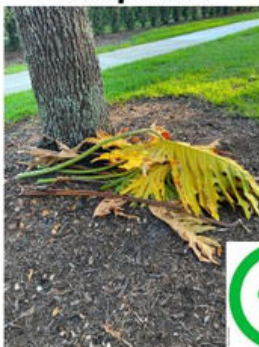

A small amount of vegetative debris* may be placed curbside in front of your property on the corner of the driveway or on the mulched area of the oak tree ring the evening before or by 7 am on the designated pick up day.

Please be respectful of your neighbors and store debris out of view until the designated day. Debris left out other than on the pick up day is in violation of IslandWalk rules.

On Wednesdays Collier County will pick up debris in paper yard waste bags (NO PLASTIC), in personal bins (up to 45 gal), or tied with twine in bundles no longer than 4 ft.

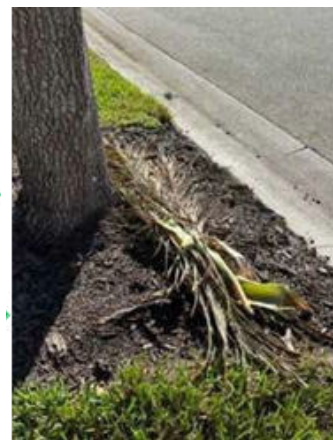
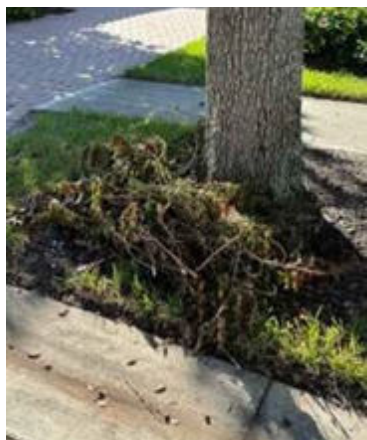
LAWN DEBRIS DO'S & DON'TS

Don't leave large piles of debris for Juniper. Our contract does not provide for pick-up of large amounts.

Don't allow your private landscaper to leave debris behind after they have trimmed your trees or shrubs.



Do - put **small amounts** of lawn trimmings and fallen fronds at the street in front of your home on Monday or Tuesday. Juniper picks up the West side on Mondays and the East side on Tuesdays.

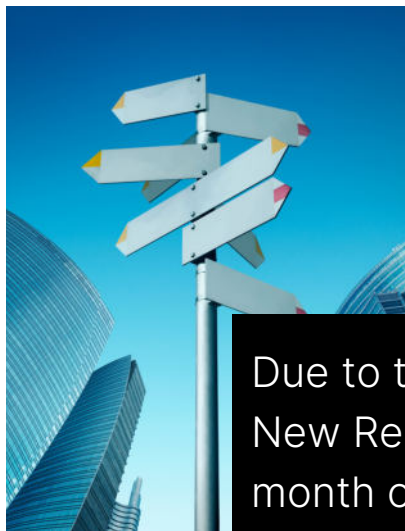
