SAND ON PAVERS – FRONT EXIT GATE

The sand placed on the pavers at the front exit gate has been added as a protective measure

Purpose of the sand:

- To prevent damage to the pavers caused by frequent movement of large trucks and heavy vehicles due to roads project
- To reduce tire grip on the paver surface, which helps avoid visible tire marks and impressions

Your cooperation in driving carefully over the sanded area is appreciated to help us maintain the appearance and durability of the pavers.

FROM THE ACC: House Painting Anyone?

If you are planning to paint your home -

- 1.Obtain and read the ACC Requirements & Procedures, dated 04.09.2025. See Painting section.
- 2.Obtain the Intent to Paint form, dated 2.14.2024

This will save you time. If you have old forms, your application may not be correct and will be held or rejected until it is correct. Forms are available at the Town Center and on the Island Walk website IslandWalk-hoa.com under FORMS and ACC. Instructions are included on the form.

Planning to paint your house, trim, shutters, privacy wall? Here's how to make sure the color you request is correct. All Island Walk colors are based on PPG color codes. You or your contractor need to confirm that the paint brand you use is an EXACT MATCH with the PPG codes so the colors throughout Island Walk will

be correct and uniform.

If you choose the Town Center color scheme, you will need to follow additional special instructions and sign a form saying that you will follow them. Paraffin body color requires using only Desert Dune trim, and these colors cannot be used with any other paint combinations. Accent colors are for doors and shutters only. You must give these instructions to your painter, and make sure they are followed. You will be responsible for any deviations from the rules. You'll see on the form that all paint colors and trim colors are required to be satin finish. Paint with a sheen or shine is not approved. If you have questions, please ask in the office 239–513–0045.

A small amount of vegetative debris* may be placed curbside in front of your property on the corner of the driveway or on the mulched area of the oak tree ring the evening before or by 7 am on the designated pick up day.

Please be respectful of your neighbors and store debris out of view until the designated day. Debris left out other than on the pick up day is in violation of IslandWalk rules.

On Wednesdays Collier County will pick up debris in paper yard waste bags (NO PLASTIC), in personal bins (up to 45 gal), or tied with twine in bundles no longer than 4 ft.

LAWN DEBRIS DO'S & DON'TS

Don't leave large piles of debris for Juniper. Our contract does not provide for pick-up of large amounts.

Don't allow your private landscaper to leave debris behind after they have trimmed your trees or shrubs.



Do - put **small amounts** of lawn trimmings and fallen fronds at the street in <u>front of your home</u> on Monday or Tuesday. Juniper picks up the West side on Mondays and the East side on Tuesdays.



DO – use **PAPER ONLY LAWN WASTE BAGS** which are picked up on <u>Wednesdays</u> by the county (trash day)

Collier County Sheriff's Office is offering free Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training as follows:

Mondays from 6-9 pm on Sept. 22 - Nov. 10 (8 sessions) at VillageWalk Naples on Vanderbilt Beach Road

OR

Saturdays from 9-5 on Oct. 4, Oct. 18 and Nov. 1 at Naples Italian American Foundation on Airport-Pulling Road

CERT trains the public in basic disaster response skills such as team organization, disaster medical operations, fire safety, and light search and rescue. The ability for CERT volunteers to perform these activities frees up professional responders to focus their efforts on more complex, essential, and critical tasks.
