# Compliance Committee

### Quick Reminder About Violation Notices

As a friendly reminder to all homeowners, if you receive a violation notice, you have 15 days to either:

- Respond to your Compliance Coordinator with your planned next steps, or
- Complete the work needed to resolve the issue

If no response or action is taken within that 15-day window, the violation will be forwarded to the Committee, and fines may be assessed.

Please note: Some violations, such as damaging Association property or overnight parking, are considered non-curable and will be sent directly to the committee without the 15-day grace period.

Tips for Staying in Compliance To help keep Island Walk beautiful and in compliance with community standards, please review these important reminders: 1.Exterior Modifications Any exterior changes require prior approval from the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). This includes installing or removing landscaping, adding new house numbers, or making any other exterior modifications. 2.Parking Rules No overnight parking is permitted on any common area between 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM. This includes, but is not limited to, the street around the Arubas and the apron at the end of the driveway. No vehicle shall be parked at any time on any sidewalk or portion of a driveway which would block, in whole or in part, the sidewalk, or prevent. access to another Unit's driveway. No vehicle, including golf carts, shall be parked at any time on any. vegetation, including grass. In accordance with Florida Statute 316.195, parking vehicles the wrong way.

must be parallel to and within 12 inches of the right-hand curb.

3.Pet Etiquette

· Please keep dogs on a leash at all times when outdoors.

Be courteous to neighbors and pick up after your pets.

4.Outdoor Appearance

 Ensure there are no loose items (such as tiles or debris) left outside your home.

on any Island Walk street is prohibited. The right-hand wheels of a vehicle

Fruit trees are not permitted anywhere in Island Walk.

Each lot must have at least one County-approved Florida native hardwood tree.

Please make sure all exterior walls, including privacy walls, driveway, roof & gutters, lanai, and all other walls are free of mold, weeds, mildew, dirt, or rust.

Any outside equipment, such as pool equipment or AC units, must be screened using ACC-approved 15-gallon shrubs or planting material, with 3 plants on each visible side. The landscape screen height must match or exceed the height of the equipment.

5. Temporary Equipment & Vehicle Placement

All pods, dumpsters, U-Hauls, and similar items must display a permit issued by the Town Center, facing the street side, before placement on the driveway.

6. Garbage Containers

Please store garbage containers in your garage on non-collection days.

7. Golf Cart Registration & Operation

Residents who own or lease golf carts to be driven in Island Walk must register such golf carts with the Association.

Golf carts must be non-gasoline powered.

All drivers of golf carts must have a valid automobile driver's license.

- ✓ NO ACC APPROVAL NEEDED AS LONG AS YOU FOLLOW THE DATES AND RULES IN THIS FLYER, YOU'RE GOOD TO GO!
- ! NOTE: NOT FOLLOWING THESE RULES IS A CLASS II VIOLATION.
  - IMPORTANT REMINDERS:
- NO DECORATIONS ALLOWED IN ANY COMMON AREA OF ISLAND WALK.
- P HOLIDAY FLAGS (MAX SIZE: 4.5 FT X 6 FT) COUNT AS SEASONAL DECORATIONS AND MUST FOLLOW THE HOLIDAY TIMEFRAMES BELOW.
- LARGE INFLATABLES ARE ONLY ALLOWED DURING: HALLOWEEN, CHRISTMAS, HANUKKAH, AND KWANZAA
- BE MINDFUL OF LANDSCAPERS DECORATIONS MUST NOT BLOCK OR INTERFERE WITH LAWN CARE. IF DAMAGED, HOMEOWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY RESULTING COSTS.

A small amount of vegetative debris\* may be placed curbside in front of your property on the corner of the driveway or on the mulched area of the oak tree ring the evening before or by 7 am on the designated pick up day.

Please be respectful of your neighbors and store debris out of view until the designated day. Debris left out other than on the pick up day is in violation of IslandWalk rules.

On Wednesdays Collier County will pick up debris in paper yard waste bags (NO PLASTIC), in personal bins (up to 45 gal), or tied with twine in bundles no longer than 4 ft.

### lawn Debris Do's and Don'ts

**Don't** leave large piles of debris for Juniper. Our contract does not provide for pick-up of large amounts.

**Don't** allow your private landscaper to leave debris behind after they have trimmed your trees or shrubs.



**Do** - put **small amounts** of lawn trimmings and fallen fronds at the street in <u>front of your home</u> on Monday or Tuesday. Juniper picks up the West side on Mondays and the East side on Tuesdays.



**DO** – use **PAPER ONLY LAWN WASTE BAGS** which are picked up on <u>Wednesdays</u> by the county (trash day)
