



Lakes Committee Notes – October 24th, 2025
We are in the process of planting our fall 2025 littorals. This will include 17,400
plants consisting of Arrowhead, Pickerelweed, Golden Canna and Blue Flag Iris on
11 of our ponds.

We do this to help stabilize our shoreline, reduce the nutrients load, reduce algae bloom, enable habitat for fish and birds and beautify the lakes. We have over 18 miles (95,000 feet) of shoreline in Island Walk which is an area equivalent in the gulf from Naples pier to Big Hickory Pass in Estero.

We are now in the process of planning the plantings and erosion control for 2026. You can help us by letting us know if you need or would like some littoral plants behind your home. Also please check to see if you have any erosion or washouts. We have a lot of shoreline to check, a limited budget and a small committee, so we can't check everywhere. We need your comments. Please email us at iwlakeeyes@gmail.com.
