

- IF YOUR AUTOMATIC PAYMENT IS SET TO BE WITHDRAWN IN THE 2025 CALENDAR YEAR, YOU WILL NEED TO ADJUST THE AMOUNT WITHDRAWN TO THE NEW ASSESSMENT AMOUNT OR CHANGE THE WITHDRAWAL DATE TO BE IN 2026.
- IF YOU HAVE YOUR BANK AUTOMATICALLY MAIL IN A CHECK FOR YOU EACH QUARTER VIA BILL PAY, YOU WILL NEED TO NOTIFY YOUR BANK OF THE NEW PAYMENT AMOUNT.



 NO ACC APPROVAL NEEDED - AS LONG AS YOU FOLLOW THE DATES AND RULES IN THIS FLYER, YOU'RE GOOD TO GO!

 NOTE: NOT FOLLOWING THESE RULES IS A CLASS II VIOLATION.

### ! IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

 NO DECORATIONS ALLOWED IN ANY COMMON AREA OF ISLAND WALK.

 HOLIDAY FLAGS (MAX SIZE: 4.5 FT X 6 FT) COUNT AS SEASONAL DECORATIONS AND MUST FOLLOW THE HOLIDAY TIMEFRAMES BELOW

 LARGE INFLATABLES ARE ONLY ALLOWED DURING: HALLOWEEN, CHRISTMAS, HANUKKAH, AND KWANZAA

 BE MINDFUL OF LANDSCAPERS - DECORATIONS MUST NOT BLOCK OR INTERFERE WITH LAWN CARE. IF DAMAGED, HOMEOWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY RESULTING COSTS.

# 2025 LAKE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN'S REPORT



2025 was a busy and productive year for the Island Walk Lakes committee and in turn the lakes of Island Walk. Our committee gained 3 new members, lost 2, ending up with 11 permanent members and one on sabbatical. We held 11 monthly meetings. Our lake level above sea level started out at 10.3 feet and ended at 9.4 feet with a high of 11.2 feet in July and a low of 7.6 feet in June.

We accomplished several items including:

- Installed new fountains in our two front entry ponds
- Started to replace the older equipment in our Aeration System with current technology including three new cabinets with 10 new compressors, 236 new diffusers (aerators) and sinking all of the floating tubing lines
- Wrote and received board approval on a new Mission and Charter
- Wrote and received board approval on a checklist for the maintenance of our boat
- Added 5,500 Shellcracker and 1,500 Bluegill fish in our lakes
- Planted 17,400 new littoral plants on our shoreline
- Hosted a Bird Watching Seminar with Chris Heinz
- Attended a Lake & Ponds Workshop at the Naples Botanical Gardens hosted by the Rookery Bay Research Reserve
- Attended the Annual Lake Watch Volunteer Appreciation Dinner and continued our association with the Florida State Lake Watch Program

# To access CONCUR website, you need to create an account.

## Registration is simple:

[1] Go to TownSquare (IslandWalkwebsite) Under News&Events Tab Is CONCUR.

Go into CONCUR, From CONCUR click "here to be redirected to the CONCUR login portal.

[2] Fill in the form using the information as known to the HOA: these must be exactly same values as the HOA name and address. Fields marked as "Required" cannot be skipped. You can include an optional nickname if you wish to. but the "Required" fields must match the HOA data - this ensures that only owners may access the site.

[3] Fill in security questions and answers that will help you recover a forgotten password. At least one set is required.

[4] Solve the math problem and click the "Request Code" button. Your registration password will be generated, displayed, and emailed to the address you supplied.

Now that you have a password, you can go to <https://iw-concur.com> and fill in your house number - 1234 - and your new password, then click "Enter". The site will then permit entry. Once logged in, you may change your password to something that is easier for you to remember: click the "Home" tab, then "Edit Profile" to modify any information you wish to change. The "User's Guide" button can be very useful in understanding the information available on the site.

If you encounter any issues, or have any suggestions about the site, feel free to get in touch. Note that most pages - including the login and the registration pages - will have a "Help"



button in the upper-right, just below the menus and the logo. This will frequently provide a quick answer to questions about the page.



A small amount of vegetative debris\* may be placed curbside in front of your property on the corner of the driveway or on the mulched area of the oak tree ring the evening before or by 7 am on the designated pick up day.

**Please be respectful of your neighbors and store debris out of view until the designated day. Debris left out other than on the pick up day is in violation of IslandWalk rules.**

On Wednesdays Collier County will pick up debris in paper yard waste bags (NO PLASTIC), in personal bins (up to 45 gal), or tied with twine in bundles no longer than 4 ft.

# Lawn Debris Do's and Don'ts

**Don't** leave large piles of debris for Juniper. Our contract does not provide for pick-up of large amounts.

**Don't** allow your private landscaper to leave debris behind after they have trimmed your trees or shrubs.



**Do** - put **small amounts** of lawn trimmings and fallen fronds at the street in front of your home on Monday or Tuesday. Juniper picks up the West side on Mondays and the East side on Tuesdays.



**DO** – use **PAPER ONLY LAWN WASTE BAGS** which are picked up on Wednesdays by the county (trash day)
